

## Identifying Lice

1. Look at the nape or the neck, around ears and at the crown of the head for the presence of nits (eggs) They will look light on dark hair and look like dirt on very blond or red hair. The real test is if it is stuck to the hair shaft and is hard to pull off with your fingernails, it is a lice egg (nit). Regardless of whether or not you see a bug, lice are present and the hair needs to be treated.
2. Determine if other members of the household have lice and inform people who have been in close contact with the affected person. Lice are transmitted from head to head and members of the household are most at risk.
